PERMIT CONDITIONS

The following conditions are requirements for the permit to be issued. Any violation of any of the conditions or violations of the New Jersey Uniformed Fire Code shall result in the non-issuance and or revocation of the permit.

- Failure to completely fill out all information in this application shall result in the application being rejected with no refund of the application fee. A completed application may be re-submitted utilizing the original application fee for the rejected application.
- Propane tanks shall be properly secured, in good condition and within the Hydro Test compliance date.
- Propane piping and hoses shall be in good condition and free from any leaks. Staff shall be knowledgeable in leak detection and have the means / material to check for leaks prior to operation. Leak testing shall be documented by staff as to the time testing was performed that day.
- Placards shall be provided on propane cabinets and “No Smoking” signs shall be posted.
- If generator is being utilized for power, the generator shall be located away from any combustibles and shall have a fuel supply that will allow the generator to operate without refueling during the event. If the generator needs to be re-filled, it must be allowed to cool enough that the muffler is cool to the touch.
- The hood suppression system shall have a current inspection tag posted.
- A listed “K” class fire extinguisher shall be required for any deep-frying operation. The extinguisher shall have a current inspection tag. The extinguisher shall be readily accessible to the operator.
- A listed 2A:10B:C rated fire extinguisher shall also be provided with current tag.
- A UL listed carbon monoxide alarm shall be provided.
- A listed LP-gas and or Methane alarm shall be provided depending on the type of fuel being utilized.
- LP-gas containers installed on the vehicle and fuel-gas piping systems shall be inspected annually by an *approved* inspection agency or a company that is registered with the U.S. Department of Transportation to requalify LP-gas cylinders, to ensure that system components are free from damage, suitable for the intended service and not subject to leaking. CNG containers shall be inspected every 3 years in a qualified service facility. CNG containers shall not be used past their expiration date as listed on the manufacturer’s container label. Upon satisfactory inspection, the *approved* inspection agency shall affix a tag on the fuel gas system or within the vehicle indicating the name of the inspection agency and the date of satisfactory inspection. In lieu of a tag, a letter on letterhead, with the raised seal of the entity certifying the system, may be acceptable. The letter shall identify the vehicle via license plate or vehicle identification number.
- Mobile food vendor’s vehicles, trailers, booths, and carts shall be located a minimum of ten (10) feet from other vendors, structures, means of egress, and means of egress pathways.
- All tensioned membrane structures, tents and canopies shall also be maintained a minimum of ten (10) feet from the vendors vehicles, trailers, carts, structures, means of egress and means of egress pathways.
- The 2018 International Fire Code New Jersey Edition Chapter 3 Section 319 Titled Mobile Food Preparation Vehicles and all other chapters of the Code shall be followed.
- Provide a copy of the Business Registration Certificate by the New Jersey Division of Taxation

I hereby acknowledge that I have read this application and that the information given is correct, and that I am the owner, or duly authorized to act in the owner’s behalf, and as such agree to comply with all applicable requirements of the N.J. Uniform Fire Code and the conditions set forth for this permit. The undersigned agrees and understands that the application fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
